

The Socialist Workers candidates in New York State, who are meat packers, garment workers, and other working-class fighters, are part of the growing resistance by working people to the bosses' assaults on our jobs, wages, conditions, and social gains. They have joined with and supported bus drivers on strike in Queens for health benefits and job security, Carpenters and Laborers—together with their giant "rats"—campaigning for union recognition at construction sites in the city, protests against cop brutality, defenders of women's access to abortion, and farmers' fights against foreclosures.

As the bosses shut plants, lay off workers, and gut health and pension benefits, the Socialist Workers propose a program to unite working people in a fight for our common interests:

- **Jobs for all! Shorten the workweek with no pay cut. Launch a massive public works program with jobs at union scale to build and repair schools, hospitals, bridges, and roads.**
- **Defend and expand affirmative action. Raise the minimum wage.**
- **Cancel the Third World debt that is squeezing working people from Argentina to Turkey.**
- **Stop INS raids and deportations! No secret detentions or trials! Abolish the death penalty!**

We call for replacing the government of the billionaire minority with a workers and farmers government. The Cuban Revolution is a living example that it is possible for working people to stand up to the mightiest power on earth, make a revolution, and use political power in the interests of the majority.
